

## Child Care at the Kane County Children's Waiting Room

The Children's Waiting Room (CWR) located on the Lower Level of the Kane County Judicial Center provides free, short-term, supervised care for children of persons with court related business.

Children up to the age of 12 are accepted if the adult will be in the Kane County Judicial Center. If the adult will be in one of the off-site locations, the child(ren) must be potty trained. The eligible, off-site locations include: Kane County Courthouse (Geneva), Kane Branch Court (St. Charles), Kane County Juvenile Justice Center (St. Charles), and Kane County Adult Corrections Center (St. Charles).

The hours of operation are 8:15 a.m. to 4:15 p.m. Monday through Thursday; and 8:15 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on Fridays, with extended hours of operation for night court participants based on need. Children must be picked up during the lunch hour Monday through Thursday. The CWR is not open on weekends or court holidays.

The adult checking the child(ren) in must be the same adult for pick-up and to attend to any needs a child may have during the day. No solid food, no diaper changes, and no medications will be administered by the staff. Bottles and sippy cups are acceptable. If the adult is needed in the CWR for any reason, the adult will be notified on a pager provided by the CWR.

At check-in, a one-page registration must be completed and photo I.D. may be requested. Additional instructions and rules will be provided at the time of drop-off. Violations of rules or disruptive, uncontrollable children may result in denial of further acceptance.
