#### **IMPORTANT NOTICE OF MEDIATION** FOR EVICTION CASES ONLY

You are being served with an eviction complaint which could result in losing your housing and possibly paying the Plaintiff money. Call the <u>Kane County Eviction Mediation Program</u> to learn more about the eviction and mediation process. Only you or a lawyer can appear in court on your behalf. You may <u>not</u> send a friend or relative in your place. There are resources available for people in your situation.

### Mediation can help you avoid eviction.

Mediation is a safe space with a neutral third party to help landlords and tenants communicate to voluntarily and mutually resolve issues outside of court. Your attorney may attend the mediation with you. Mediation is a free alternative to the court process, but there is no guarantee that an agreement may be reached by both parties. All discussions are confidential.
