Executive Director of Kane County Court Services Appointed to Cost of Supervision/Detention Task Force

On March 10, 2021, Lisa Aust, Executive Director of the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit Kane County Court Services, was selected to be a member of the Cost of Supervision/Detention Task Force.

This task force is one of several task forces that the Illinois Judicial Conference developed to achieve eleven Strategic Initiatives during 2021. These Task Forces and Initiatives are part of an inaugural strategic plan for the Illinois Judicial Branch that the Illinois Supreme Court adopted in 2019.

Ms. Aust was identified through a vetting process undertaken by the Illinois Judicial Conference and senior staff of the Association of Illinois Courts, as one of the most qualified individuals to be on this task force. The Illinois Supreme Court approved the appointment.

“While we all remain uncertain of what the court system will look like in the future, we do know that the focus and momentum surrounding these Strategic Initiatives will ensure a more just, equitable, and practical justice system in the future despite these difficult circumstances,” wrote Honorable Anne M.
